Mr. JENSEN asked that the information not be used by the Bureau in any way which would indicate to any other agency that the information came from the Danish Security Service. He also requested that any additional information developed by the Bureau concerning ALLEY's contact with ABARCHALINE of the Soviet Embassy in Copenhagen be furnished to him because of their continued interest in ABARCHALINE's intelligence activities in Denmark. From the information contained in the enclosit it would appear that these meetings were certainly clandestine in nature and also that books and periodicals were passed a between the two.
