CUBAN INTELLIGENCE ACTIVITIES IN THE U. S.
INTERNAL SECURITY - CUBA

Our letter dated June 13, 1969, transmitted a memorandum which showed that a Cuban refugee in the U. S. reportedly had been instructed by a Cuban intelligence officer to proceed to Cuba for special training in the use of eavesdropping equipment and to thereafter return to this country and monitor President Nixon's conversations at his Key Biscayne, Florida, residence. Enclosed is a memorandum dated August 13, 1969, which shows the Cubans are putting pressure on the refugee to proceed with this mission.

The enclosure also details the activities of other Cuban intelligence officers stationed at the Cuban Mission to the United Nations in New York City as officials. You will note that these officials are blatantly carrying out activities inconsistent with their assigned duties at the United Nations.

Information in the enclosure has been made available to the Honorable Henry A. Kissinger at the White House, the State Department, the Central Intelligence Agency, the Department of Transportation, the Secret Service and the military intelligence agencies. Our investigation is continuing and you will be provided any additional pertinent information received concerning the Cuban Intelligence Service's interest in President Nixon.
