Referenced communications reflect that on July 30, 1951 authorized complaints were filed and warrants issued by the United States Commissioner, El Paso, Texas charging PEREIRA and LEE with Conspiracy, Interstate Transportation of Stolen Property and Mail Fraud. Complaints were based upon information furnished by Mrs. GERTRUDE J. JUTTE FEFEIRA, Roswell, New Mexico. On April 19, 151 GERTRUBE CONCE, wealthy widow, age 55, and her sister, KATHRIN JOYNER, age 30, came to El Paso, Texas, stopping at the fashionable Del Norte Hotel. LEE and FERIFA, staying at the same hotel, struck up an acquaintance and returned to Poswell, New Maxico with these two women a few days later as house guests. LEE posed as an oil lease operator and PEREIRA posed as a smalthy sportsman, who had just been divorced and had \$48,000 coming in a short time from a property settlement. A whirlwind courtship culminated in the marriage of PEREIRA and Mrs. JOYCE in Kansas City, Missouri on May 25, 1951. LEE had proposed narriage to JOYNER and between the time of the original meeting and June 21, 1951 LEE and PEREIRA defrauded Mrs. JOYUE of a total of \$47,000 and a Cadillac automobile. Subjects disappeared on about June 21, 1951 and their whereabouts is unknown. These communications further reflect that FERSIFA, FBI number 21573h9, and LEE are probably associates of PAUL AUGUSTUS KID, FBT. number 2594295, JOE P. DOWDING, FBI number 477053, J. P. DOWATUE, FBI number 427053, Sidney "DOC" SOLWAY, FBI number 76762 and EDWAED SOLWAY, FBI number 847381. It is reflected that LYONS might be identical with LEE and that all of these individuals are suspected of being involved in a widespread "con racket". LEE was described as white, male, 6 feet, $1\frac{1}{2}$ inches tall, weight 185 pounds, light brown hair, blue eyes, whale fellow, well-meth, possibly driving 1950 black canillac.

It was further stated that subjects and possibly some of their associates mentioned above might be headquartering in Denver, Colorado and perpetrating confidence games from Denver to the West Coast. It was requested that those offices receiving copies of communications furnish information concerning LEZ and FERRIPA that might result in their apprehension.

The files of the Denver Office contain no reference to VICTOR EMMNUEL PERZIPA.

There is set out below information contained in the Denver files concerning PAUL AUGUSTUS KING, was; JAMES ERABLEY LYE, was, and other persons who have possibly associated with subjects.

By letter dated January 31, 1719 the Chaha Office furnished the following information relative to HING and his associates:

"PAUL JISEFH ASHFORD, 3301 Jackson Street, Sicux City, Iowa, Telephone #71046, is a fairly wealtny Landowner, and he stated he purchased a dude ranch near Florrisant, Colorado. He advised he decided to sell the same and informed PAT FLAVMERY, owner of the Famous Ear in Kannas City, of his intentions.

*ASERCED related that subject PAUL AUGUSTA AND, alias Gus Ring, wrote him at Sioux City from the Hotel New Yorker in New York City, stating he would be interested in purchasing this dude ranch, and ASEFCED is of the opinion that FLAMMERY informed KEMS about the dude ranch. ASEFCED stated that through correspondence a meeting was arranged at Denver, Colorado, in Warch, 1946, and that he proceeded to Denver with an associate by the name of HUMH MCCUE of Sicux City; that KIMS was staying at the Brown Falace in Denver and was in the company of a man by the name of BUD FRAMELS and another male individual named JUNE who operates the Silver Dollar Used Car Lot at Denver, Colorado. ASEFCED related that KING and he visited the dude ranch and then returned to the Brown Palace Hotel in Denver where KING entertained in his guite in an elaborate manner. ASSFORD flew to Kansas City on Thursday, November 18, 1948, and went to the Phillips Hetel, had a few drinks with KPNG and ate dinadir with him at the Famous Bar, At this time toth the BFAMBLES and Had II b. Wo.D-WARD were with KING. KDWG suggestic driving to Dallas that ISEFIAD decided he would rather fly, which he did, and this group evidently proceeded to Dallas by automobile. We said he met this eroup at the Schor Hotel Friday Evening, November 19, 1948, and as he entered the hotel at approximately 9:30 7.8. XIB adviced that his son, who was a smoder of the Southern Methodist University team, had just left the hotel.

"Saturday after the football game ASTFORD went to this group's botel room at about 5:30 P.M. and stayed until 10:00 or 11:00 P.M. "Rewriet dated July 18, 1951, requesting a surrary of information in the Puresu's files concerning James Harry Polan, Gus A. King, was., and Ernie Woodard, was. The following is being furnished pursuant to your request.

"JAMES HAFRY DOLAN - The Burcauts indices fail to reflect any information wiles can be identified as being identical with subject Dolan.

General Crime Survey import, dated October 15, 1946, reflects that Faul A. King, originally of Atlanta, Georgia, took part in crocked card genes, principally gin rumny, and was an associate of one Ted Clark of Plani Beach, Florida. These individuals were reported to have numbered among their victims several prominent individuals.

Miami Crime Survey Report, dated April 29, 1947, reports
Paul Augustus King as being a card shark from Atlanta, Georgia,
who has been picked up in crooked card and dice games in Miami Beach,
Florida. It was reported that he partook in several crooked card
games during the 1945-1946 winter season, and was arrested on March 21,
1947, after a complaint had been made that he and one Fred Brown had
been swindling by meens of card and dice games. They were each fined
\$200.00 on March 26, 1947 on a vagrancy charge.

"The report of Si J. Michard Butts dated June 19, 1917, rat Wiami, Florida, entitled, "Socialist Workers Party, Newark Field Division - Internal Security - SUP", reflects that one Faul King is a known gambler and has been reportedly involved in the swindling of mealthy persons in chamin do for and gin runny games in that area.

"Mew York Gureral Crime Survey report for November 26, 1917, reflects that on September 11, 1967 the New York City Police Department conducted a raid of a sixth floor suite at the Hotel Marguery, 270 Park Avenue and seized elaborate crocked gambling equipment. This equipment included a trick picture with plass affording one-may vision, which hung on the mall of the gambling den. A watcher pasking through this from the next room could read the cards of their intermed victim and signal the play to an accomplice at a table by means of electric equipment. Also saized were meanly 2,000 pairs of crocked dice, numerous decks of marked cards and michanical appliances for sleeving cards. Among those arrested was one Faul A. King, ago 53. Fing was charged with conspiracy to entice players into begus card games. There is no information reflecting the disposition of this charge.

*From the available information it is not possible to state definitely that the above-monthshed individuals are identical with the subject.

MOther references to King are set forth in the crime survey reports submitted by your office under the dates of October 18, 1949, April 17, 1950 and July 20, 1950.

"Miami letter dated March 27, 1981 to the Bureau contains information regarding a Poul Augustus King, was, FBI Number 2894298. A copy of this letter was directed to your office.

KING further related that in 1947 he was fined \$50.00 in Atlanta, Georgia on a gambling charge, after a complaint had been made that he and FRED HERRY had been operating a "crooked game."

KING stated that he first met ERNIE B. WOODWARD, alias "BIG EARS WOODLED in Miami, Florida in 1935. He stated that WOODWARD was a garbler and was then operating at the Frolics, described by KING as a Mirmi resort. He stated that WOODWARD had frequented gandling ments in the vicinity of Saratoga, New York and at Saratoga had, with a man by the name of SULLIVAN new deceased, promoted a moort coublishment known as Piping Rock. He stated that WOODWARD hai also wern appropriated with an establishment in Saratoga called "De Monione" in 1948. He related that at the present time FRMIE B. 40000000 is still operative as a gambler; that he travels extensively to various resort awas in the United States and that he resides on 67th Street Terrace in Kaises City, Missouri, where he owns an expensive residence. KDsC stated that he, in the surrer season of 1948, rented a summer home at the HICKS place on Lockout Mountain with D. M. CAREY and that ESMIS S. JOUNGARY from ently came there from Kensas City to visit. He stated that D. M. CAREY operates the Wagner Machine and Supply Company on York Street in Denver, and is a heavy gambler. KBG stated that in 1/49 he mented a summer place near Bergan Park, Coloredo with the THEODORY SATLERIOM, a clothing company executive and gambler of New York City.

He stated that in the summer of 1950 he and CAREY rented a summer establishment at 2031 Midway, Colorno Springs, Colorado. He stated that since dume 1951 he, with CAREY and CAREY's wife, "GOLDIE" has rented the HIDES place on Lookout Mountain near Denver; that they are usually there every weekend and frequently have house quests and card games. He mentioned one of his quests as being ELLIS LUTION, Fredick to the Lupton Mining Company, Georgetown, Colorado. He stated that LUCTON is a mining promoter and is not a gambler.

imong his other associates KING mentioned MID BRAMELE and JOHN RELUIES, brothers. He described them as "hot dice men", who live in Kanses City, Nicroum, but stated that they pechaionally come to Denver and during the summer opera season of 1948 at Central City, Octorado the PRIMELES operated a dice game for CLYDE and "CHECKERS" SMILDO'E (reported to control gambling operations in the Denver area).

He stated that he has for a number of years been acquainted with GEPALD D. ALLIE, and JERRY ALLEN, who resides at 12th and Olive Street, Denver, Colorado, and maintains an office in the C. A. Johnson Fullding in Denver. He stated that ALLEN helds patent rights on a vibrating mattress presently being manufactured by the Serta Manufacturing Company. by gamblers in the Denver area as being a *welcher and alcheat*; that he frequents big dies games in Denver hotels and has made a lot of money gambling.

KING stated that he first mot CLYDE and "CHECKERS" SMALDCE in Contral City in about 1943 when they were operating a number of garbling establishments. He stated he occasionally goes to Gaetanos Restaurant, which is owned and operated by the SMALDCES in Danvey Colorab. He continued, heaver, that he has no business dealings with the SMALDCES and that he is not connected with any type of organized gambling operations. He stated that he mat CHALLE SMACOID and BINACHO's beauguard, CHARLES BARGOTTA at the Phillips Botel in Kensas City in 1919 and was introduced to them by the manager of the hotel, a Mr. FREERIL. He stated that he never had any association with BINACHO or any organized operations in Eansas City and only saw BINACHO on this one occasion.

KING stated that he mot RAYMOND JAKES CONLEY and JOSEPH RAYMOND SNELL mantipred above for the first time on New Years Day, 1951, in his suite at the Eaker Hotel, Dallas, Pexas. He stated that on that eccasion he was having a party in his suite while down to see the football game with his son "BUDDY" KING and that SNELL and CONLEY came in and wanted to start a dice game. He stated that he knew them by reputation as gamblers and received touts; that he desired to have a "respectable party" that day and dicent permit them to gamble. He stated that the only time he had seen CONLEY and SNELL was on a few occasions during June 1951, when he ran across them in the lobby of the Cosmopolitan Hotel in Durver.

KING related that he has been acquainted with JAMES ERABLEY IEE since 12h7, having not him at that time in Mint, Floreds. He stated that he believed LEE's true name is FURNIZERADING He described LeE as a "lover boy", "con man" and gambler. He stated that LEE has for a number of years frequenter gambling establishments and beach clubs in the vicinity of Mint, Florida and has also spent considerable time in Phoenix, Arizona. He stated that he last saw LEE on about March 1, 1951, at which time LEE was at the Westward Ho Hotel in Phoenix. He said that during the latter part of March he saw LEE on several occasions around Phoenix resorts. He stated that LEE's method of operation is to get acquainted with mealthy women, proteind to be in love with them, and "snake them down" for large sums of money. In this connection KING volunteered information that on June 29, 1951 while he was in Denver, Colorado he received a long distance telephone call from Mrs. VINCINIE VAN HORMAN, who lives at 3111 Zunis Street, Tulsa, Oklahoma. Mrs. VAN NORMAN informed him that JAMES BRADLEY LEE had just defrauded her out of \$5,000. KPHG said that it was his impression that Mrs. VAN NORMAN suspected him of being associated with LEE in this swindle. He stated that he assured her that he had nothing to do with this affair, although he thought she was correct in stating that LEE had swindled her out of the miney inasmuch as he knows that this is LEE's regular method of operation. He described Mrs. VAN NORMAN as a divorce, a woman of considerable wealth, who came from a prominent family in Tulsa. He stated that her parents are Mr. and Mrs. C. A.
