Investigation in this matter was conducted at Denver, Colorado by SA FRED G. McGEARY and the reporting agent.

county of Benver informed that the records of her office from January 1, 1948 to September 5, 1951 contained no record of a divorce proceeding involving VICTOR EMANUEL PERSIRA.

Mr. PAUL PORPORIO, Clerk's Office, County Court, city and county of Denver informed that the records of his office from January 1, 1948 to September 5, 1951 contain no record of a divorce proceeding involving VICTOR EVANUEL PERSINA.

Confidential Informant, Denver, T-1 of known reliability exhibited to the writer original telegram dated April 24, 1951, and received for transmittal at Denver, Colorado at 11:26 A. M. on April 24, 1951. This telegram is addressed to VICTOR BY TREERA, 401 West 11th Street, Roswell, New Mexico, in care of GERRIDS OVER and reads as follows:

"Your net figure in property settlement, \$48,895. Distribution will be made May 25. Final divorce effective April 28. Best personal regards. Hope to see you soon." Signed, "CURTIS"

It was noted that this message was hand printed by the sender in rencil and according to Informat, it was sent from the headquarters office of the Western Union in Denver, Colorado. Informant had no information us to the identity of "CURTIS".

Confidential Informant, Denver, T-2, an associate of gamblers and "con word, who has in the most furnished reliable information to this critice, are who is will toquarated with FIGTOR Facility Facility, was 20 EEEE H. BRIDER, was, and SAMERI SIDNEY SOLUTAY, informed that he was in Phoenix, arizona from January, 1951 to April 14, 1951, and during that puriod was in contact with FEREINA, BRADING and SOLUTAY from time to time. We recalled that shortly after he returned to Denver, around the middle of April, 1951 he was informed that PREZINA had been in telephonic communication with CURTIS RYMMENER, President of the Magner Machine and Hill Supply Company, 4444 York Street, Denver, Colorado. Informent related that to his knowledge CURTIS R. WACNER is the only person in Denver

who has a first or last name of "CURTIS" with whom VICTOR EMANUEL PERKIRA

Informant stated that CURTES R. WACNER is a former Kansas City, Missouri Police Officer; that while he was in Kansas City WACNER was a friend of D. M. CAREY, formerly in Kansas City, now residing in Denver, California. He stated that CAREY is a big-time garbler and has furnished transfer became to AREER in connection with Warner inclined and IIII Supply Company. He stated that both WACNER and CAREY have in the past been friendly with VICTOR EMANUEL PEREIRA, and that CAREY is well acquainted with SANGEL SHINEY SOLOWAY and JAMES BRADLEY IEE. He pointed out that to his personal knowledge CAREY sponsored PEREIRA'S membership in the Elks Club in Denver, a year or so ago.

Informant stated that he has no personal knowledge of the deals or arrangements made by the subjects in the present case but he knows, from associations with them that PEREIRA and BRADING are "lover boys" and "con men" who make a business of preying upon gullible, wealthy woken, extending offers of marriage and then shaking them down for large sums of money. He further stated that he knows SANNEL SIDNET SOLOWAY as "DOCK SCHOWAY, that SOLOWAY has for many years been a big-time "con man" and would be interested in any deal where there was a possibility of picking up a substantial sum of money. He further stated that between January and April of 1951 PEREIRA, SOLOWAY and BRADING, together with JCCK BONDING, described by the Informant as an old time "con man" spent considerable time at the Adams Hotel and the Westward Ho Hotel in Phoenix, Arizona.

Informant was questioned as to the identity of Unknown Subject, wa., E. J. WIISON. He promptly stated that the only B. J. WIISON he knows who might be acquainted with PEREIRA, ERADING and SCHOOLY is EDEARD J. WIISON of Henet, California. He stated that EDEARD J. WIISON of Henet, California. He stated that EDEARD J. Informant stated that he personally met EDMARD J. WIISCN in Colorado Springs, Colorado at the Broadmoor Hotel in the summer of 1950 and at that time WIISCN was accompanied by EUCENE H. BRADING (using the tame JAMES BRADIEY LEE) and JOCK DOWDING. He stated that WIISCN presented a very nice appearance, appeared to be in good health and played golf frequently at the Broadmoor golf course. He believes that at that time WIISCN was residing at the Broadmoor Hotel, which is a very fashionable resort hat a state of the stated that it is his understanding from conversations with willow. He stated that it is his understanding conversations with persons who are acquainted with WIISCN, that the latter, although residing in Hemet, California, frequently travels to resort areas around the country. He had no personal knowledge as to whether WIISCN was in Phoenix, Arizona between January and April, 1951 or whether he was in the state of Texas during that period. He pointed out however, that since WIISCN is apparently a good friend of JAMES ERADIEY IEE, he is also undoubtedly acquainted with "Doc" SOLOMAY and VICTOR EMENUEL PRESIRA.

Informant also pointed out that to his knowledge, the only associate of PEREIRA and BRADING (wa., IEE) who has ever used the name of "SIDNEY" is SAXUEL SIDNEY SCIONAY, wa., "Doc" SCIONAY, and he has no doubt that if PEREIRA and BRADING were perpetrating a scheme to defraud anybody out of a substantial sum of money, SCIONAY would not hesitate to assist them if he could personally derive any money from the scheme.

With further reference to PRIEIRA, T-2 stated that Mrs. ADA PEREIRA, about three years ago obtained a divorce from VICTOR EMAURI.

FRIEIRA at Reno, Neveda. He stated that for a period of two or three years, up until about six months ago Mrs. PEREIRA operated the St. Francis Hotel in Denver, and that VICTOL PEREIRA frequently made the statement that he was financially interested in this hotel but extually hadro interest therein. Et Al: IMPERSONATION; CONSPIRACY" at which time WIISON was visiting his nephew at 3520 Burke Avenue, Seattle, Washington. At that time, he was accompanied by his wife BISIE E. WIISON. He gave his

permanent address as 800 East Florida Street, Hemet, California.

Preliminary inquiry concerning WILSON at Hemet, California, conducted by the San Diego Office reflected that he was supposed to be a retired businessman, and was mentioned to have formerly resided in liari, Florida, where he had extensive property holdings. It further are according that WILSON and his wife enjoyed a favorable reputation in Hemet, around the country. In connection with this case, it appeared that he lay, 1951 JAMES HEMRY DOLAN had deposited in a Denver bank a check in the around of \$2,063, drawn on the Citisen's National Trust and Savings Bank of Hemet, California and signed by ELSIE B. WILSON. DOLAN is a crooked abler and "com man" and is presently at liberty under \$5,000 bond in Denver, Colorado on a Federal charge of impersonating an agent of the Writed States Bureau of Internal Revenue.

When EDWAFD J. WIISCN was interviewed concerning his association with DOIAN he appeared to be somewhat evasive; claimed that he was in poor health and that his memory was faulty. He stated, however, that he had met DOIAN in Ias Vegas, Nevada in January, 1951 and held a casual conversation with him at that time. He again met DOIAN when the latter was traveling through Hemet, California in April of 1951. On the second meeting, WIISCN claimed that he became involved in a poker game with DOIAN and several businessmen in Hemet, California, and at that time DOIAN won \$2,065 from him, which amount WIISCN paid to DOIAN by check. He stated that his wife EISTE E. WIISCN signed the check. He explained to her that the same representated payment to DOIAN for the purchase of some stock.

It is pointed out that Confidential Informant T-2 mentioned above, has reported that while DOIAN was in Phoenix, Arisona during January and February, 1951 he frequently associated with "DOC" SOIOWAY, CAN DE PRADIEY IEE and "JOCK" DOWDING.

Mr. KARL MERIAE, Assistant Manager, Brown Palace Hot.1, Denver, advised that hotel records contained no information reflecting that FEMERA or BRADING had been registered those during the last two years. Its produced records reflecting that "S#8010MAY", 2219 Fort Worth Avenue, Dallas, Texas was registered at the hotel on July 19, 1951 in Room 415 and checked out on July 20, 1951.

Lr. AL CONGER, Credit Manager, Cosmopolitan Hotel advised that their records reflected that "S. SOLOMAY", 735 Fort Worth Avenue, Dallas, leves was registered at the Cosmopolitan Hotel from January 7, 1951 to

While at the Cosmopolitan Hotel on August 3, 1951 SCHOWAT placed two long distance telephone calls to Chicago, Illinois, telephone, number Long Seach 1-8500, which phone is listed to a "BOCKE SCHOWAT," a Chicago physician.

Records of the Casampelaide. Sold instain to information reflecting that EUGENE H. BRADING, wa., JAMES BRADIZY LES has been registered there. However, the records indicate that Mr. and Mrs. VICTOR PERERA, 1617 O. Street, Sacramento, California, were registered there from April 21, 1960 to April 23, 1960.

Confidential Informant T-2 informed that during August, 1951 while SOLUTA! was registered at the Cosmopolitan Hotel, he was drinking heavily and appeared to be in need of money. Informant stated that at the time SOLUMAY-left the Cosmopolitan Hotel on August 17, 1951 he stated that he was going to Chicago, Illinois to visit his brother, whom he described as a practicing physician in Chicago.

STEPHEN STABLEY SAMBOR, 1519 Laurel, Hollywood, California, a gambler, presently residing at the Cosmopolitan Hotel in Denver and who states that he is in Denver to attend the Racing Meet at Centennial Race Track, informed that he is acquainted with "DOC" SOLOMAY, and during August, 1151 saw him frequently in Denver. He stated that SOLOMAY has been dishiping heavily in recent months and left Denver around the middle of August to go to Chicago, Illineis, where, according to SAMBOR, SOLOMAY has a brother who is a physician. He was unable to furnish the full name of SOLOMAY'S brother.

hr. MORGAN HAIGHT, Assistant Manager, Shirley Sever Hotel informed that hotel records since January 1, 1950 contained he reference to PERSIRA, BRADING or SOLOGIAT.
