This letter being classified "Secret" due
to information received from another agency which
was so classified. (S)(u)

Referenced teletype advised that information
received by CIA after four Guatemalan revolutionaries
had been arrested in Mexico. Undated information re-
covered at the time of that arrest identified the
captioned as associated with the "North American
Congress on Latin America" and recommended that he
be contacted (implying that he would probably be
sympathetic to the Guatemalan Revolutionary Movement).
This document described the Subject as "VICTOR PEREIRA:
Guatemalan citizen; resides Los Altos, California;
employed as journalist for 'New York Times'". Because
this document indicated that the Subject would possibly
be contacted by Foreign Intelligence Service, CIA re-
quested any information available on the Subject.
