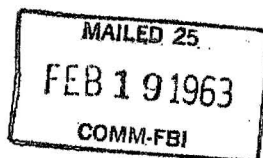

Page 44 of rerep contains information furnished by
NY 204-C (NY T-3) to the effect that a bookmaking operation
supposedly controlled by the subject is being handled by one
Buddy (LNU) and by one Louis Necca who reportedly handled bets
through a telephone answering service.

The Criminal Division of the Department has expressed
a particular interest in this matter in view of the fact that
the Internal Revenue Service has developed similar information but
from a different source. The Internal Revenue Service source
is stated to be an individual who has been a manufacturer and
installer of "cheeseboxes" and similar devices as well as having
been a wiretapper.

In view of the Department's interest, you should
contact the informant and conduct additional logical investigation
to develop as fully as possible information concerning this
operation. Submit the information developed in a letterhead
memorandum suitable for dissemination to reach the Bureau no
later than 3/8/63. a
