LEASES name didnot appear as connected with this company in any way OTHER 4 On 2/15/56 PCI advised that Dr. CANAL had been associated with the track since the beginning of its operation as general manager and that he had been made president of the new racing company to gain the support and confidence of the Cuban public According to the source, the track was more than \$200,000.00 in debt at the time the DELCA RACING COMPANY was formed. Source also stated that since the appearance of GEORGE LEVIME. at the track on 2/3/56, LEASE has not been seen around. Source said that LEASE was reported to be in the States trying to raise money.
