On July 29, 1963, [redacted]
[redacted] who is under consideration for development as
a PSI by the Miami Office, was contacted in connection
with another matter by Special Agent JOSEPH P. McCANN.
[redacted] identity should be protected, he should be
validated as having furnished reliable information in
the past, and he should be described as an ex-member
of the Cuban Revolutionary Army, who is familiar with
anti-CASTRO activities in the Miami area.

He advised upon viewing a photograph of MAX
GARCIA, that this individual has accompanied DOMINICK
BARTONE during BARTONE's contacts with one LUIS BALBUENA. *USIT*
[redacted] said he is quite certain that the photograph of
MAX GARCIA is of the individual who accompanies BARTONE,
and who appears to act as his bodyguard.

The photograph shown to [redacted] and upon which
this identification is based is the photograph dated
December 6, 1955, obtained from the files of the Tampa,
Florida, Police Department #APP 13367.

Miami will obtain additional information con-
cerning GARCIA's association with BARTONE through recon-
tact with [redacted] and Tampa will be advised.
