Dr. ERNESTO ARAGON, 233 E. 69th St., NYC, Delegate of the Consejo Revolucionario de Cuba (CRC), was in contact with the NYO on 1/22/63. Dr. ARAGON advised that he had accompanied Dr. JOSE MIRO CARDONA, President of the CRC, on 12/4/62, to Minneapolis, Minnesota, where they spent two days because Dr. MIRO CARDONA spoke at a college near Minneapolis, and was also a guest speaker at a dinner in Minneapolis. After returning from Minneapolis, Minnesota, Dr. ARAGON advised that he has spent most of his time in Washington, D.C., except for a weekend visit to his family during the Christmas holidays. Dr. ARAGON advised that he had returned from Washington on 1/17/63, as his wife was entering a NY hospital for a minor operation and since she has now returned home, he was departing on the afternoon of 1/22/63 for Washington, D.C. (S)(u)

For the information of the WFO, Dr. ERNESTO ARAGON y GODOY is residing at the La Salle Apartment Hotel, Apartment 622, 1020 Connecticut Avenue, Northwest, Washington, D.C., and his telephone number is 296-5550. (S)(u)

Dr. ARAGON, on 1/22/63, advised that during the month of December, prior to Christmas, he spent most of his time in Washington, D.C., conferring with US State Department and Pentagon officials relative to problems which had arisen at Fort Knox, Kentucky, where the Cubans were stationed who volunteered for US military service. (S)(u)
