NOTE:

Army, in May, 1967, advised Miami Office it had source  
who desired to remain anonymous. Source stated he was in Montreal,  
Canada, in July, 1964 with some Cuban revolutionaries who buried  
explosives on an island. Source believed material was still there  
and furnished maps showing their location. We passed data to RCMP  
which has already recovered limpet mine.

RCMP is endeavoring to locate other explosives and in  
this connection has advised that it is preparing to dig up the  
island. RCMP has requested the source be recontacted for specific  
information concerning the location of the other explosives. We  
have determined that the source is in Spain and we have asked  
Miami Office to determine from Army whether it is willing to dis-  
close identity and specific whereabouts of its source so we can  
advise RCMP in the event it desires to have him contacted there.
