CUBAN REFUGEE PROBLEM IN THE UNITED STATES
INTERNAL SECURITY - CUBA

On March 19, 1962, a confidential source abroad furnished two documents, copies of which are attached.

The first document contains the names and backgrounds of seven refugees who arrived in the Cayman Islands in an open boat on February 27, 1962. The boat was taken back to Cuba. (5)

The second document contains the background of six Cubans who arrived in Nassau on February 22, 1962. According to the confidential source, Rafael Reyes Olivero, who is mentioned in this document, had been forced by the other five men to take them from Nicaro Bay, Cuba, in his fifty-foot ferry boat, the "Catskill." On January 30, 1962, they were wrecked on an uninhabited cay in the Bahamas and the vessel! was totally destroyed. On February 17, 1962, they were picked up by a Haitian boat and taken to Ragged Island in the Bahamas. With the exception of Reyes, all the Cubans mentioned in the second document desire to go to Miami. Reyes desires to return to his wife and seven children in Cuba, but is afraid of reprisals by the Cuban The escapees gave as their reasons for leaving Government. Cuba that the Cuban Government was bad and was causing starvation. One man said he left because of starvation and communism./c
