This report contains information from Bureau Source 5 as contained in the title and is not to be disseminated (S)

DAVID DALLIN and LYDIA ESTRIN, who are two of the most important individuals to be interviewed in connection with this case, are still traveling in Europe and the latest inquiry concerning them indicates the possibility they may return to the U.S. in November of this year. They will be interviewed as soon as possible on their return. (S)(u)

In regard to the Fourth International aspect of this matter the reports of operator 15 of the NYCPD who operated in the SWP from about 1941 to 1946, were reviewed on 10/5/53 at the Bureau of Special Services and Investigation but no pertinent information was obtained. (S)(u)

The case file on ERNEST E. ERBER, former member of the National Committee of the Workers Party, who broke with them in 1948 and who has been interviewed by the Newark Office, was reviewed and no pertinent information was found. (S)(u)

It is noted that ERBER was active with the Workers Party in Philadelphia up until 1945 and he did not come to NYC until about the early part of 1946. A further review of the file on the SWP is being made for any information which might be of assistance in this aspect of the matter. (S)(u)
