States BORIS SOUVARINE is best anti-Communist intellectual known to him. Information concerning JOAQUIN MAURIN and SOUVARINE set forth. Contact with KRAVCHENKO, background and other information concerning BORIS NICOLAEVSKY set forth. **NICOLAEVSKY** does not appear to be good suspect for Tulip, but cannot be entirely eliminated. HAROLD ISAACS eliminated as suspect.
