In view of the paucity of information concerning this incident set forth in the enclosure you are requested to advise whether MI-5 can utilize the information contained in the enclosure to your 8/5/68 letter as well as the information in the enclosure to the referenced communication to warn the subject and his wife that their involvement in anti-Castro activities is known to the authorities and that they must not engage in such activities while they are in the Bahamas.
