MONTHLY SUMMARY OF ACCOMPLISHMENTS

Re Buairtel to Albany, 2/15/65, and Dallas airtel to Bureau, 8/5/65.

As per instructions in referenced Bureau airtel, the following information is being set forth concerning accomplishments by the Dallas Division:

1. The Dallas Division presently has four Agents assigned to the Criminal Intelligence Program; however, it should be noted that during the month of August one Agent was on sick leave the entire month and Agents assigned to the squad were on annual leave a total of 15 working days.

2. During the month of July, 1965, a total of 43 man days were expended on the program with 84 man days assigned. During the month of August, 1965, a total of 57 man days were expended on the program with 88 man days assigned, making a total for both months of 100 days expended on the program with a total of 172 man days assigned.

3. The Dallas Division presently has one top echelon informant (DL-275-PCM).

4. The Dallas Division has one identified La Cosa Nostra member (JOSEPH FRANCIS CIVELLO). The Dallas Division has instituted several investigations on other Italians as mentioned in referenced Dallas airtel to ascertain if they are members of the La Cosa Nostra.
