On 5/9/66, JOSEPH CIVELLO was observed at the Airway Liquor Store at approximately 10:00 AM, conversing with his brother, CHARLES. At approximately 2:00 PM that same date, JOSEPH CIVELLO was observed working in the yard at his residence, 4908 Gulf Stream.

On 5/10/66, JOSEPH CIVELLO was again observed working in the yard at his residence at 9:30 AM until 10:45 AM. During the afternoon that same date, JOSEPH CIVELLO was observed working in the yard at his brother's residence at 3747 Sugar Mill Road.

On 5/11/66, JOSEPH CIVELLO was observed in his yard trimming shrubbery at 9:15 AM until approximately 9:40 AM. At 11:50 AM he was observed to arrive at Airway Liquor Store. At 1:50 PM that same date, he was observed working in the liquor store. At 5:30 PM that same date, 5/11/66, until 7:30 PM the subject's automobile and the automobile belonging to ROSS MUSSO were observed parked in the garage of the residence. No unusual activity was noted during this period.

On 5/12/66, surveilance was instituted in the area of JOSEPH CIVELLO's residence from 9:15 AM until approximately 1:00 PM. It was noted that CIVELLO's automobile was parked in the garage during this period, however, JOSEPH CIVELLO was not observed.

From 5:00 PM to 7:40 PM that same date, 5/12/66, surveillance in the area of CIVELLO's residence determined that his automobile and the automobile registered to ROSS MUSSO were parked in the garage and that no visitors were observed to visit at CIVELLO's residence.

On 5/13/66, DL 275-CTE advised that JOSEPH CIVELLO had visited the Airway Liquor Store on a daily basis during the week of 5/9 - 13/66. He also advised that MUSSO and CHARLES CIVELLO were observed at the liquor store on a daily basis handling the business. Informant advised that he has not observed any known gamblers or characters visiting the liquor store.

Om 5/13/66, PCI JOHN BROWN (DL 137-1802) advised that he has not observed any visitor at the JOSEPH CIVELLO residence during the evening hours from 5/8 through 5/12/66. He stated that in conversing with JOSEPH CIVELLO, CIVELLO has not indicated that he plans to travel outside the Dallas area in the near future.

RE: JOHNNIE ROSS PATRONO, aka
AR (DL 92-231)

Daily spot checks of the subject's residence at 4411 Munger has failed to indicate that the subject is having visitors at his residence. It is noted on one occasion that subject apparently had borrowed an automobile from Dallas bookmaker - used car dealer, BOBBY JOB CHAPMAN, in that a 1961 brown Buick convertible was observed parked in the driveway bearing dealer tags listed to CHAPMAN. It was also noted that apparently the subject's brother and mother are continuing the operation of wholesale meat business, operating from the residence.

RE: RUSSELL DOUGLAS MATTHEWS aka

On 5/13/66, DL 275-CTE (DL 137-1733), advised that MATTHEWS continues to visit Denny's Restaurant, 3130 West Mockingbird Lane, on an almost daily basis for either breakfast or lunch. He stated he had received information that MATTHEWS was recently at the Cotton Bowl Bowling Alley, Inwood Road and Lemmon Avenue and was in a drunken condition and was threatening several of the patrons playing pool. Informant stated that a barber by occupation, approximately 65 years old allegedly pulled a gun on MATTHEWS and threatened to kill him. He stated that MATTHEWS allegedly backed down and commenced apologizing, which is an indication to the informant that MATTHEWS is not the strong arm hoodlum that he makes out to be. -70 X85

On 5/13/66, JOYCE STONE, the prostitute wife of the subject, was interviewed at her residence by Buagents concerning the present whereabouts of the subject. She stated that she has not personally talked with the subject since the first part of April, 1966; however, he occasionally calls her but does not tell her where he is located. She stated that when he returned the first of April, he had mentioned to her that he had been arrested in Virginia in the company of MARION ROBERT RAIF and his wife, LUCY CAMP. When agents arrived at the residence they were admitted by DONNA SUE HELTON, also a known prostitute and presently residing with JOYCE STONE.

RE: JAMES C. COLE IGA (DL 162-372)

On 5/12/66, captioned subject was interviewed at his liquor store located on Abrams Road concerning his bookmaking activities. COLE advised that he had a small operation when raided by the Dallas PD on 2/11/66. He stated that he had laid off his bets with Dallas bookmaking gambler ALBERT MEADOWS (DL 166-84). He stated that after the raid MEADOWS allegedly discontinued his bookmaking operation in that he did not want to be embarrassed by an arrest prior to his trial on ITAR-Gambling charges. COLE also advised that he is aware that BRUCE BRUNO (162-321) of Fort Worth, Texas, is a bookmaker but that he, COLE, has never placed any bets with him. He stated that approximately one year previously, an individual had used his telephone in the liquor store to place bets with BRUNO.

RE: NORVELL YOUNG STANFIELD, aka ITWI (DL 165-153) 7 475

On 5/10/66, DL 197-C (DL 137-1411) advised that Follows STANFIELD had recently returned to Dallas from his vacation trip to England and Europe. He stated that he has not talked with him but understands that he returned to Dallas during the latter part of the week from May 2 to 6, 1966. He advised that it is very unlikely that STANFIELD will commence bookmaking in that he has never been known to take bets on baseball games. He stated that STANFIELD is known to only book football and basketball.
