Williams returned to the Bahama Islands where they were picked up by British authorities with two Cubans who had been left to guard the disabled "Aladino." The British authorities returned Hughes and Williams to the United States but held the two Cubans for lack of visas to enter the United States

Masferrer has alleged the invasion departed from a neutral country. Inquiry to date indicates the group left Miami on two separate boats for a rendezvous point in the Bahama Islands and from there departed on its invasion of Cuba. The Department has been furnished all information to date and has been requested to furnish its opinion whether the facts developed indicate a violation of neutrality statutes under our jurisdiction (particularly Section 960, Title 18, United States Code, Organizing an Expedition) and warrant further investigation. All information developed to date has also been furnished to State Department, Central Intelligence Agency, military intelligence agencies, Bureau of Customs, Immigration and Naturalization Service, and the Joint Staff.
