Source Six advised that 'Solocum II' departed Miani for Cuba

The "Olokum II", a 63 foot air-sea rescue boat painted white and green with two gasoline engines and capable at traveling at 25 mph, is owned by CARLOS ZAYAS, a close friend of ROLANDO WASFERRER.

This boat was used by ZAYAS and MASFERRER when they fled from Cuba, arriving at Key West, Florida, after the fall of the BATISTA regime on January 1, 1959.

Since that time the boat has been at several different locations in Miami and under observation of United States Customs and United States Border Patrol and has not left the Miami area.

On April 28, 1959, ROLANDO MASFERRER advised that although the boat is legally owned by ZATAS it is under his, MASFERRER's, control, and has not been away from the Miami area.

MASFERRER stated that about five weeks ago ARNOLD RAYBER, New York arms dealer, wanted to buy the boat from him, but no sale was made.
