Regarding ["MARY CANAS"] (S) the possibility exists that she might be [the "Candi" drop] (S). This supposition is based on the fact that the word ["canas"] (S) could be translated from [Spanish] (S) to be ["cane"] (S), as in sugar cane, which might be thought of as [candy] (S). Miami realizes this possibility is remote, but feels that every possibility must be explored. (S)

In view of [Cuba's message to subject] (S) Sunday, 12/15/63 regarding the ["Candi" drop] (S), the Lab should handle [the CANAS letter] (S) with extra caution. (S)
