u.s.A. NO 1075-C advised he told PECORA he thought the \$5,000 CIACCIO wanted for fixing his zoning problem was too much and that he thought he should mention this to ANTHONY BOLOGNA, father-in-law of CIACCIO. NO 1075-C said he told PECORA that they should help an old friend a little. Source said PECORA used a group of obscene phrases in referring contemptuously to BOLOGNA, and source thought this was unusual since BOLOGNA furnished PECORA with the money to buy the Tropical in the first place.
