A confidential source, who has furnished reliable information in the past, has advised that Tourine, a well-known gambler and racketeer, recently related that he had met with a number of his hoodlum associates to discuss detrimental effects the investigations by the Federal Government agencies were having among the gambling element. According to Tourine, the hoodlums met to reach agreement on the course of action which would be best for them to take to slow down the anticrime drive.

Tourine and his group, according to the source's information, were of the opinion that the only logical approach available to them was to attempt to influence you through an intermediary. They decided that they would try to accomplish this objective by approaching officials close to you.

The above is furnished for your information. You will be immediately advised of any additional information received in this matter.

Delvecchio has been interviewed by Special Agents of WFO in the past, but was belligerent and uncooperative.
