Enclosed herewith to the Bureau are six copies of a letterhead memorandum dated as above and captioned "MARIO MARCO FORTINI." Two copies are designated for Miami and two to Philadelphia for information since FORTINI resides in Philadelphia territory.

This memorandum represents investigation by SA KENNETH J. HASER.

For info Miami and Philadelphia, relet directed that FORTINI's passport record be reviewed as a result of a request from New Scotland Yard for information on a number of individuals believed connected with gambling matters in England, including FORTINI.

In May, 1962, WFO received information that the Bureau of Narcotics was interested in TOURINE's contemplated trip to Europe during the summer of 1962. On 7/5/62, SA WALTER MORRIS, Bureau of Narcotics, Washington, D.C., advised SA JOHN R. BUCKLEY that he had received information (from an undisclosed source) that TOURINE was to meet an individual named DE MARCO in Switzerland, during the summer of 1962.
