Brigadier GUIDO ZARA, Confidential Squad, Italian National Police, Rome, Italy (protect identity), advised on January 2, 1963, that a check of the Foreigner's Office and Tourist Bureau, Italian Police, Rome, Italy, did not reveal any record of TOURINE having been in Rome, Italy. Mr. HENRY L. MANFREDI, U. S. Narcotics Bureau, Rome, Italy, advised on January 15, 1963, that he had not received any new information regarding TOURINE. He advised that his office continues to maintain stops for TOURINE throughout Italy and that he would advise the Rome office should he receive any information. Dr. ARISTIDE MANOPULO, Central Bureau, Criminal Division, Italian National Police, Rome, Italy, was recontacted on January 25, 1963, relative to this matter.
