For information of all offices a case vas opened under instant caption by referenced letter based upon information developed by WFO and Baltimore that MESLIME, GEORGE MOHAMMA, JOHN RALPH "BILLY" HITCHELL and CHARLES TOURINE (CHARLIE WHITE) vere operating a large diec game in the vicinity of Ripley, Maryland, during March, 1963. Information vas subsequently developed that this game vas closed after a brief period due to the pressure of local law enforcement officers.

On 4/26/63, WF 1108-C advised SA JOHN R. BUCKLEY that TOURINE, MITCHELL and ECHANNA had octablished a dice game

on 19th Street, N.W., Washington, D.C. Informent advised that NESLIME was staying away from this operation because he did not want to draw the attention of law enforcement officers to the existence of the game.

On 5/1/63, WF 1108—C advised SA BUCKLEY that the dice game mentioned above the located at 19th and Biltmore Streets, N.W., Vashington, D.C., in a large residence and that NESLINE, although he had an interest in the operation, that not participating in the game as yet. Informant stated that TOURINE, MITCHELL and ROBANNA tore running the game but that the action was small due to a lack of players.

on 5/1/63, WF 1469-C advised SA EDVARD N. WILLS that he had heard that there was a large dice gase recently atarted at 1915 Biltmore Street, N.V. On 5/3/63, informat advised SA WILLS that he had been to 1915 Biltmore Street, N.V., the previous evening (5/2/63) and that EDMANIA and TOURING were present. ROMANIA indicated that there was not to be a dice game on that evening because of a lack of playing customers. Informant advised that CHARLIE VEITE (TOURINE) appeared to be in charge of the establishment and that on at least one occasion ROMANIA referred to TOURINE as "bode". Informant advised that the following individuals vere present at the establishment: JOSEPH CORDON, ake ENCOKLIN; ERIC ELIONSTON, ake TOM HIX; and two or three other individuals that he only knew by first name, "LARRY", "BILL" and "SMITTY".

We 1469-C described the residence at 1915 Biltmere Street as a large three story structure which was in the process of renovation of the interior. He said that there were expensive furnishings and a gold will-to-will carpet on the sain floor. Informant was told by RONAWA that the dies game would be held on the second floor of the building. Informant said that in addition to the entrance door there was an additional door which appeared to be now less tod eight or ten feet inside the entrance. It was necessary for the decrease to unlock the second door with a key.

On 5/6/63, WF 1469-C advised SA WILLS that JOE COMMON told him on 5/5/63, that there had been a fairly large dice game at the Biltmore Street establishment on the evening of Saturday, 5/4/63.

On 5/7/63, PCI, advised SA CARLTON GIOVANNETTI that he had been to 1915 Biltmore Street, N.W., on the night of Saturday, 5/4/63, and that there was a fairly large dice game held that night. PCI said that the dice game was held in a large room on the second floor and that the following individuals participated: TOURINE; HITCHELL; EUMONSTON, JIMMY LUBIN and others when he could not identify.

On 5/6/63, Deputy Chief ROY E. BLICK, Hetropolitan Police Department (MPD), advised SA ROBERT L. SHACKELFORD that he had received information that there was a gambling operation located at 1915 Biltomore Street, N.W. According to Chief BLICK he sent two Morals Division personnel (not named) to the establishment Saturday evening, 5/4/63, at approximately 10:45 p.m. Chief BLICK advised that the establishment was a large throo story structure and that the interior was lavishly furnished. According to Chief BLICK there was no gambling activity during the period that the MPD representatives were there and he advised that JOSEPH GORDON and "BILLH" HITCHELL were the only ones present.

In connection with information furnished by Chief BLICK it is likely that the MPD officers were at 1915 Biltmore Street prior to the time PCI \_\_\_\_\_ participated in the dice game the same night.

In view of the above developments it appears that the dice game at Ripley, Maryland, has been abandoned for the present. Inamuch as the operation at 1915 Biltmore Street involves substantially the same individuals as vere involved in the Ripley, Maryland, operation, it is likely that the site for the game has been seved. Accordingly it is recommended that the office of origin be changed from Baltimore to WO since it appears that the operation has been moved from Ripley, Maryland, to the District of Columbia. Extra copies are provided for the Burseu for notification to Baltimore and WFO of the change.
