"EVENING NEWS," LONDON TODAY CARRIED ARTICLE THAT SCOTLAND YARD AND FBI LOOKING FOR "CHARLIE THE BLADE" IN LONDON. THIS IS ALIAS USED BY SUBJECT. SUBJECT'S NAME NOT MENTIONED IN ARTICLE.

WIRE SERVICES INQUIRED OF EMBASSY. EMBASSY REPLIED NO INFORMATION HERE THAT THIS PERSON WANTED. PRESS PROBABLY GOT STORY FROM CIRCULARIZATION OF HOTELS BY POLICE AND FALACIOUSLY EMBELLISHED FACTS. POLICE INTERESTED ONLY IN SUBJECT'S ACTIVITIES HERE. IS NOT WANTED AND POLICE AWARE SUBJECT NOT WANTED BY BUREAU. SCOTLAND YARD DOES NOT DESIRE THAT SUBJECT BE IDENTIFIED TO PRESS; THEREFORE SUGGEST IF PRESS INQUIRIES MADE OF BUREAU, TOURINE'S IDENTITY NOT BE REVEALED.
