Re Bureau cable dated 7-9-62. Re also Rome letter dated 8-9-62.

The Central Bureau, Criminal Division, Italian National Police, Rome, Italy, has been requested to place appropriate stops and to obtain any information possible concerning CHARLES TOURINE in the event this individual is known to enter Italy. All checks made to date have met with negative results. *X(m)*

Mr. JOHN T. CUSACK, Chief of the U. S. Narcotics Bureau, Rome, Italy, advised on September 14, 1962, that his office also has stops outstanding throughout Italy concerning CHARLES TOURINE. He advised that he has received no information to date indicating that TOURINE has been in Italy. He stated that any information received in this regard would be made available to the Rome office. *X(m)*

Periodic checks will be made with Italian Police and the U. S. Narcotics Bureau for information concerning TOURINE. *X(m)*
