Referenced letter requested WFO to determine whether the individual employed by the telephone company who furnished information to SA WILLIAM D. CAMPBELL concerning the telephones of CHARLES WHITE, had knowledge of or was in any other way aware of the cooperative services rendered by the telephone company to the Bureau, particularly with regard to security matters.

The individual who furnished such information is WF 1401-S (J. FORD KELLEY, Division Commercial Manager). He does not have knowledge of telephone services furnished to WFO at the field office with regard to security matters. However, WF 1401-S does make arrangements for telephone services furnished to WFO in connection with lookouts maintained throughout the city in connection with investigations conducted in the security field.

A high-level official of the telephone company has expressed the opinion that if an official of the company were subpoenaed to testify concerning information which was supplied to WFO in confidence, it would have an adverse effect on the cooperation which the telephone company renders to this office. In view of this fact, WFO feels that every effort should be made to obviate the necessity of having a telephone company official

testify in this matter.
