Source advised that on 6/6/63, he moved a large mahogany Las Vegas-type dice table from Washington, D. C., to a small building in the rear of the Sportsman's Restaurant, St. Mary's County, Maryland, and a moving van was used. He explained that the table was moved at the direction of JOSEPH FRANCIS NESLINE and that no records were kept of the transaction.

Source stated that the dice table was to be used in a gambling operation planned by JOSEPH FRANCIS NESLINE and CHARLES TOURINE and ALLAN FISHER and as far as he knew, they were the only ones aware of his transporting the dice table.
