Remilet 6/15/64 which advised Guy Hendola, known thief and hoodlum of Chicago, had made a statement to Herola that Federal authorities had two individuals in Chicago as informants, both of whom had first names of Vito.

Chicago by sirtels dated 5/15/64 and 6/5/64 captioned, "Vito Zaccagnini, Top Echelon Criminal Informent Program," furnished to the Eureau the result of interviews of Eaccagnini. In the airtel of 6/5/64, comments are made concerning a bribery matter involving a Secret Service agent and also concerning one Vito Nitti, the subject of a case involving counterfeit Series & bonds and Bank of America capress checks.

It is not known if the above individuals are the ones to whom Mendola may have been referring.

Chicago should furnish its comments on the significance of Mendola's alloged statement to Merola.
