However, information was received to the effect that RODRIGUEZ was to be released and returned to the United States. Panamanian authorities requested to be advised as to whether or not RODRIGUEZ was wanted in the A warrant for RODRIGUEZ S arrest is outstanding at Bergen County, New Jersey, charging him with fraud.
