ADMINISTRATIVE

This report classified SECRET, because it contains information from CIA reports, so classified. ~~SECRET~~ (u)

San Juan, by airtel April 28, 1965, with enclosed LHM, furnished information regarding ARMANDO FLEITES, SNFE leader, and his reported presence in Miami. A lead was set out to interview him. Bulet May 12, 1965, instructed Miami to furnish a copy of the LHM to INS, noting that the arrival of FLEITES and other Cubans in Puerto Rico appeared to be a violation of Immigration laws. Miami was instructed to check with INS prior to interview of FLEITES.

San Juan LHM was furnished to INS Investigator GLENN ADAMS, together with information from MM 847-S, to the effect that FLEITES was hiding out in Miami to avoid INS. Mr. ADAMS said that INS was in the process of attempting to locate FLEITES in order to interview him concerning his status with Immigration. ADAMS later advised that FLEITES

voluntarily appeared at the INS office and admitted entering Puerto Rico without papers, and under an assumed name. ADAMS said that FLEITES was granted indefinite voluntary departure, and paroled by INS, which is standard procedure utilized with regard to Cuban exiles.

In view of the above, it did not appear that interview with FLEITES would serve any useful purpose. It is noted that FLEITES has been interviewed on several occasions in the past, and is not considered to be a reliable person, or cooperative.
