Re Bureau 0-7 with Legat, Ottawa let dated 7/15/74,  
captioned ~~"PERSONS IN CONTACT WITH CUBAN DIPLOMATIC ESTABLISH-~~  
~~MENTS IN CANADA."~~ (S)

Miami sources are presently being contacted regard-  
ing the subject.

On 8/21/74, MM 974-S advised that CABALEIRO resides  
at 47 Northwest 47th Avenue, Apartment 19, Miami, Florida phone  
#444-1758 and that he is an intellectual newspaperman with  
leftist views. CABALEIRO, according to source, is also  
a friend of MAX LESNIK, who is the publisher of Spanish  
language magazine, "REPLICA." LESNIK is a controversial  
figure in the Miami - Cuban exiled community. LESNIK  
originated the slogan "Cuba Si. Yankee No," during the early  
days of the CASTRO regime prior to coming to the United  
States as a refugee.

CABALEIRO, according to MM 974-S, is unfriendly  
towards the United States, favors co-existence with the  
CASTRO Government, and he does not speak against FIDEL  
CASTRO. A man of this character, who harbors these thoughts,  
is not considered a loyal member of the Cuban exiled  
community.

A Miami reference, dated 7/65, mentions one  
MANUEL CABALEIRO GONZALEZ, as being one of twelve  
commissioners of the now defunct Cuban Government in Exile  
Committee. It is not known whether above person is identical  
to subject in this case.
