WEEKLY AIRTEL SUMMARY

LA ROCCA, according to informants, is still travelling throughout the State of Florida and has not contacted any of his business operations for more than a week.

On Saturday, 2/16/63, Special Agents of the Pittsburgh Office of the FBI entered the Jockey Club at Chester, W. Va., which was being operated by JOSEPH (JO-JO) PECORA in the absence of CHARLES FREDERICK TEEMER who is vacationing at Miami, Florida. PECORA was arrested and arraigned before the United States Commissioner at Wheeling, W. Va., on 2/16/63. PG 632-C has advised that immediately following his release from incarceration on bond, PECORA visited MIKE GENOVESE at the GENOVESE farm located at RD#2, Box 149-B, Gibsonia, Pa., and remained in conference with GENOVESE for approximately five hours. GENOVESE is obviously in charge of the Pittsburgh situation during the absence of LA ROCCA, but Pittsburgh informants do not anticipate any forced return by LA ROCCA to the Pittsburgh area as a result of the Jockey Club incident.

SUBJECT SHOULD BE CONSIDERED ARMED AND DANGEROUS.
