PG 622-C* has advised that SAM TEDESCO visited the North Star Cement Block Company on McCandless Avenue in Pittsburgh, Pa., on 2/23/61, but did not indicate whether or not he came to see LA ROCCA. TEDESCO is known to the Pittsburgh Office as a burglar and expert safe man who is extremely active in the southern Ohio area. His prior connection with LA ROCCA has not been determined but the activities of TEDESCO are being fully covered by PG 575-C.

IN VIEW OF THE CONVICTION OF LA ROCCA FOR ASSAULT WITH INTENT TO KILL AND HIS ARREST FOR CARRYING A CONCEALED WEAPON, HE MAY BE ARMED AND SHOULD BE CONSIDERED DANGEROUS.
