Miami has advised that JOE BIANCO, owner of Dore's Restaurant in Dade County, Fla., has advised that although he is acquainted with LA ROCCA, he received no indication which would tend to indicate that he was in the Miami locality. The only piece of information he was able to furnish related to the fact that LA ROCCA, in about 1958, was a member of a health club which he described as quite large and located in an area not too far from the University of Pittsburgh. He recalled that this club was operated by individuals of Jewish extraction.

Miami, through the COP at Surfside, Fla., and neighbors of GABRIEL "KELLY" MANNARINO on Dickens Ave., Surfside, were unable to determine whether LA ROCCA had visited that vicinity during the months of February and March, 1961, although a maid who is employed by a neighbor stated that a photo of LA ROCCA bore some resemblance to an individual who stopped at MANNARINO's residence during the latter portion of January or early portion of February, 1961.

MM 660-C advised that he heard LA ROCCA was in the Miami area but was unable to locate his temporary residence, motel or hotel.

Spot checks at the aforementioned Dickens Ave. address of GABRIEL "KELLY" MANNARINO were negative.

IN VIEW OF THE CONVICTION OF LA ROCCA FOR ASSAULT WITH INTENT TO KILL AND HIS ARREST FOR CARRYING A CONCEALED WEAPON, HE MAY BE ARMED AND SHOULD BE CONSIDERED DANGEROUS.
