Dissemination has been made locally to the
following agencies: CIA, ONI, G-2, INS, OSI, Border
Patrol, Customs, Coast Guard and State Department,
Coordinator of Cuban Affairs.

On July 26, 1963, Lieutenant AARON ROGERS, U.S.
Coast Guard, Miami, advised if and when the boats of
Comandos L attempt to leave the Miami River, they will be
stopped and searched by U.S. Customs Agents. If no weapons
are found, then the Coast Guard will stop and board Comando
L boats, and will check for all necessary fire prevention
equipment, running lights, safety devices, papers and regis-
trations. If the boat meets these requirements, it will
then be surveilled by the Coast Guard and if it goes into
British waters, the British will be immediately notified
by the Coast Guard.
