If no weapons are found, then the Coast Guard will stop and board Comando L boats, and will check for all necessary fire prevention equipment, running lights, safety devices, papers and registrations. If the boat meets these requirements, it will then be surveilled by the Coast Guard and if it goes into British waters, the British will be immediately notified by the Coast Guard.
