Please refer to your L4230 dated 10th April, 1963, in which you asked to be informed of the identities of the nine members of the Second National Front of Escambray captured near Williams Island in the Bahamas.

We have been advised by our office in Jamaica that while in custody, the leaders of this group were seen by the security authorities in the Bahamas, but unfortunately nothing was learned about the raid of 18th March, nor was anything else of security interest discovered. The authorities did, however, recover a case of what they referred to as "codes" from Williams Island, a copy of which was passed to the Miami Coast Guard Intelligence Officer, Lt. Rogers. According to the authorities in the Bahamas, the Coast Guard Service seemed to know a lot about the raid of 18th March, and amongst other things, had a photograph of the ALISAN, the vessel from which the operation was conducted.

It may be of interest to you to know that there has been aerial patrolling of the Cay Sal and Andros area which, up to 5th May, at least, revealed no sign of any occupation by anti-Castro forces.
