





EIGHT MEN, SOME CUBAN IN APPEARANCE, WERE OBSERVED ON BOARD THE ALISAN WHICH IS APPROXIMATELY 50 FEET LONG AND OB-SERVED TO BE EQUIPPED WITH A RADIO AERIAL. THE ALISAN HAD IN TOW A SMALL TENDER AND WHAT APPEARED TO BE A SPEED BOAT ABOUT 20 FEET LONG WITH WINDSHIELD, INBOARD MOTOR AND RADIO EQUIPPED. LETTERS WHICH APPEARED TO BE F-82 WERE OBSERVED ON THE BOW OF THE ALISAN. THIS IS NOT BELIEVED TO BE A US REGISTRATION NUMBER.
