RE: ANTI-FIDEL CASIRO ACTIVITIES

Reference is made to my previous communications in this matter.

Andrew St. George, a "Life" magazine photographer who was aboard the "Alison," which was one of the two vessels involved in the March 26, 1963, Cuban exile attack leveled against a Soviet vessel in Cuban waters, furnished the following information. He stated that the "Alison" and a small speedboat departed Miami, Florida, on March 18, 1963, and left United States waters at Waters Raulover Cut and proceeded to Dini in the Bahamas and then 25 miles southeast to the vicinity of Gun Cay and Cat Cay in the Bahamas where a rendezvous was made. Q V

St. George advised that they arrived at the base of operations, which is a small rock pile in the Cay Sal Bank, where on March 19, 1963, weapons, gasoline, and explosives were loaded aboard the smaller boat. The group remained in the area of the base for several days and on March 26, 1963, the raiding group left the base and the "Alison" and proceeded to Anguilla Key and remained in that vicinity for several hours.
