FRANK MC GEE AND JERRY JACOBS, NBC, NYC, ADVISED
 INSTANT DATE THAT THEY CONDUCTED INTERVIEWS OF ANTONIO
 CUESTA, ROBERTO VALE, AND PEDRO MUINA IN MIAMI DURING
 LATTER PART OF JANUARY, 1963, FOR PROPOSED NBC ^{NEWS} SPECIAL ON
 OPERATIONS OF COMMANDOS L-66. MC GEE AND JACOBS BOTH
 STATED THAT FROM INTERVIEWS WITH ABOVE, THEY WERE INFORMED
 THAT BASE OF OPERATION IS OUTSIDE TERRITORIAL LIMITS OF U.S.
 AND WERE VERY GUARDED IN REMARKS MADE IN RESPONSE TO
 QUESTIONS ABOUT THEIR SECURING OF ARMS. MC GEE AND JACOBS
 ADVISED THAT THOSE INTERVIEWED STATED THAT THEY OBTAINED
 MONEY THROUGH CONTRIBUTIONS MADE BY CUBAN EXILES AND SOME
 AMERICAN CITIZENS IN U.S., PUERTO RICO AND OTHER COUNTRIES.
 IN INTERVIEW WITH CUESTA, CUESTA STATED THAT SMALL SPEEDBOAT
 WAS PURCHASED IN MIAMI AREA AND MOTORS WERE BOUGHT SECOND-
 HAND FROM AN UNIDENTIFIED AMERICAN MILLIONAIRE. MC GEE AND
 JACOBS ADVISED THAT THOSE INTERVIEWED WERE CONVINCED THAT
 THEY WERE NOT VIOLATING ANY U.S. LAWS AND WERE CONSCIENTIOUS
 IN THEIR ACTIONS NOT TO VIOLATE U.S. NEUTRALITY LAWS. MC GEE
