On 7-19-66 an informant of the Miami Office who has furnished reliable information in the past indicated that Eneido Oliva, a former member of Representacion Cubana en el Exilio (RCEH) and former military leader of that organization, was then in the Dominican Republic. Oliva is also a former commander in Brigade 2306. In the Dominican Republic Oliva is in contact with a Col. Juan Polch, a Dominican. Oliva is representing three anti-Castro groups, namely, RCEH, 30th of November Movement and Comandos L. Through Col. Polch Oliva is attempting to make arrangements for the establishment of a base in the Dominican Republic for the aforementioned organizations. These organizations reportedly are forming a military alliance in order to participate in anti-Castro activities.

On 7-25-66 a representative of CIA in Miami advised that CIA had an operational interest in Oliva and that Oliva was then in the Dominican Republic but was scheduled to return to the United States within a short period of time. The CIA representative was advised of the information developed by the informant concerning anti-Castro activities in the Dominican Republic.

Any pertinent information received in this matter should be promptly furnished the Bureau. [The interest of CIA in Oliva] of course, is for your confidential information and must not be disseminated outside the Bureau. In the event any additional pertinent information concerning anti-Castro activities in the Dominican Republic is received, it will be made available to you. No active inquiries concerning these activities are desired by your office at this time.
