It is noted that [] during interview, declined to give the location of captioned organization's base of operations outside the United States and flatly stated that the organization was receiving no help and wanted no help from the United States Government. He also indicated that his superiors in the organization were cognizant of his contact with the FBI. *RU*

The enclosed LHM is classified "Confidential" because [] requested that his identity not be made known outside the United States Government circles and also because Miami letter and LHM dated 3/29/66 indicated that the United States Army Field Appraisal Detachment, Miami, Florida, had an operational interest in TONY CUESTA and about 15 other members of Comandos L. It is felt that unauthorized disclosure of the info in the LHM could be harmful to United States Defense interests. *dv*
