PRICE from CLAY KRUCKEMEYER dated 11/17/64 at San Antonio, Texas, from The Minuteman Club naming him a charter member of the San Antonio Branch. Also enclosed are 2 Electrostats each of his statement as to his annual dues, a blank application for membership, and the calling card of DENNIS BURKHOLDER, which identifies him as an insurance salesman with the National Guardian Benefit Life Insurance Company. One copy of each of the above are being enclosed for the Kansas City office.

On November 19, 1964, [redacted] Attorney with offices in Room 212, Milan Building, San Antonio, Texas, telephonically called the San Antonio Division regarding a meeting of retired U. S. Marine Corps officers held in San Antonio, November 17, 1964. At this meeting he stated

Will check credit and criminal records at Dallas on WILLIAM H. PRICE. Will, if feasible, check records of USMC Reserve in Dallas for background information on PRICE and confirm his attendance at USMCR meetings in Dallas.
