PSI [] who is presently residing and working in "Minutemen" Headquarters in Norborne, Missouri, on December 6, 1965, while en route to mail approximately 450 envelopes of "Minutemen" material, contacted SA GEORGE A. ARNETT, and advised that if desired, the addresses on these envelopes could be copied. This was done and the envelopes were immediately taken to the Post Office with no delay.

[] advised that most of the envelopes were addressed by him and all of the envelopes were sealed and stamped by him. He stated each envelope contained copies of the December issue of "On Target" and the "December, 1965-Bulletin".

PSI also furnished a list of 17 addresses to which he was mailing copies of these items in bulk. He advised he believes these 17 addresses to be the addresses of either Regional Coordinators or Team Captains.
