Synopsis:

POPE's release from Dallas County Jail on bond arranged by local top hoodlum NICK CASCIO, FBI #692074. Details of POPE's arrest at Oklahoma City 3/27/58, set out. Information regarding POPE's criminal activities set out. Local prosecutive action against POPE planned for early June, 1958, by Dallas District Attorney's Office. SUBJECT HAS BEEN KNOWN TO USE A KNIFE IN A FIGHT, CARRIES A .38 SNUB NOSE REVOLVER ON PERSON, WAS IN POSSESSION OF .45 CALIBER AUTOMATIC DURING RECENT ARREST, HAS SAWED-OFF SHOTGUN AND SHOULD BE CONSIDERED ARMED AND EXTREMELY DANGEROUS. POPE HAS MADE STATEMENTS THAT HE WOULD KILL ANY OFFICER WHO ATTEMPTED TO ARREST HIM.
