On 11/6/62, Ers. ULDA BLDEED, Registration Section, Internal Security Division, V. S. Dopt. of Justice, made available to SA JUSEFU E. SCULLY correspondence covering subject's recent contacts with the Registration Section. following info was obtained from the correspondence furnished by Ers. MARKD:

A latter from the Registration Section dated 6/28/62. addressed to Colonel John B. Kieffer, 24848 Chevy Chase Boulevard, Chovy Chase, Maryland, referred to a telephonic request made by KIBFFER on that date and enclosed forms for his use in filing a registration statement under the provisions of the Poreign Agents Degistration Act of 1988, as amended in connection with his activities on behalf of a Cuban group, (not further identified).

A eccorandom of a telephone call dated 8/6/62 reflected the following info:

The telephone call referred to apparently took place between Colonel ELEFFER and MATHAN B. LENVIN of the Registration KIEFFER said he had somewhat of a peoplexing problem concerning Departmental regulations. He had a feeling that he should register with the department but was not sure that it was required. He said he was going to work as an advisor and consultant to United Organizations for the Liberation of Cuba. a Florida organization. KIEFFER would serve as an advisor to the Executive Secretary and .00% of his work would be done outside of the United States. KISFFER would not be working on a definite calary, but on a fee basis. He has no written agreement with the organization and has no supporting documents. KIRFFER acknowledged his June contact with the Registration Section and indicated that he had received certain forms from the Registration Section.

Br. LEEVIN told LIEFFER that he thought the above organization was registered but folt that if it was not he thought it should be. Hr. LEEVIN told KIEFFER he would send him forms 4-A to facilitate him registration and KIEFFER indicated that he would check with the organization and see that they register right away. It was noted in the memorandum that MARIO CARCIA KONLY was reflected as head of the organization.

For the info of the Bureau, although Mr. LENVIII indicated that he thought MELT's organization should be registered his meno reflected no basis for this reasoning.
