First Secretary to the Iraq Mission to the United Nations, has 6
made inquiries concerning the purchase of sophisticated weapons, including weapons with silencers. (Al-Tayyar) indicated that an individual in a position to furnish such weapons was Rosser Scott Reeves, III, Chairman of the Board of Quantum Corporation, 450 Park Avenue, New York City. Quantum Corporation is a holding corporation for Military Armament Corporation of Marietta, Georgia, and for Cromwell Corporation, also of 450 Park Avenue.

In January, 1975, an individual named William Apikian, 21 Avenue du Jour, Ferney Voltaire, France, flew to New York and also engaged in extensive negotiations with a number of American concerns concerning the purchase of sophisticated weapons. George Salesky, an executive with Military Armament Corporation in Marietta, Georgia, had discussions with these two individuals concerning the possibility of evading United States State Department regulations by shipment to other countries in the Middle East.
