On 11/16/61 DL-2-S and DL-16-S, who have furnished reliable information in the past, advised SA W. HARLAN BROWN that this organization was unknown to them and they had no information concerning 1t.

On 11/27/61 DL-6-8, who has furnished reliable information in the past, was contacted by SA W. HARLAN BROWN and reported that informant knew of no organization called "MINUTEMEN" organized and operating in this area.

On 11/30/61 DL-107-C (RAC) and PCI (RAC). advised they had no information to the effect that any organization known as "MINUTEMEN" in this area. Both advised that in the event information of this kind was obtained it would be transmitted to the Dallas Office.

On 12/6/61 Lt. JACK REVILL (protect), Intelligence Unit, Dallas Police Department, stated that his office had no record of "MINUTEMEN," and knew of no branches of that organization operating in this area. REVILL stated that an article appeared in one of the Dallas daily newspapers to the effect that an organization had been formed in the Los Angeles area but that no information had been received that the organization was operating in Dallas. Surcia.

It is noted that the last three mentioned informants were contacted by SA JAMES P. HOSTY, JR., and have furnished reliable information in the past.
