In the case of EUTENEUER we learn that she is probably the author of a letter, which is enlisting the support of individuals for the MM organization. The last two paragraphs of this letter are indicative of her dedication to the aims and purposes of MM:

"As 'we the people', have no recourse through the courts of the land, a national committee has been established to conduct citizen's trials of the traitors responsible for our situation.

"It is one of the responsibilities of this organization to bring these traitors to justice. With your help, our task will be easier. As America needs the strength of all her patriots in the critical days ahead, I hope to hear from you at your first opportunity."

In the case of WALKER. He was interviewed in connection with the JOHN ROBERT HARRELL - FUGITIVE case, (Bufile 42-157640). WALKER at first withheld information from Bureau Agents and on second interview admitted that he drove HARRELL and was with HARRELL in January, 1963. WALKER could possibly be one of the leaders of MM in Denver area.

We feel that these three individuals should be investigated to determine their dangerousness, and whether they have violated or would violate any laws of U.S. Although these individuals and the MM organization cannot be categorized as followers of Communist or SWP philosophy, consideration should be given to their published aims and objectives inimical to the welfare of the U.S.

However, in accordance with Bureau suggestions, investigations of these three individuals under separate case files will be discontinued.

source of information or a racial informant.

As will no doubt be qualified in the future as a confidential source or racial informant, information received from him and included in rerep should receive the same protection as that information we will receive from him in the future.

Bureau requested information as to extent and results of investigation conducted as to units outside of the Denver area. Investigation, to the present time, fails to reflect any MM units outside the Denver area; however, investigation is still continuing. It is noted that Philadelphia was requested to interview as to his knowledge of MM activity in this area. It is our opinion that when more information is obtained about individual members of MM, consideration will be given to seek Bureau authority to interview some of the members, in effort to obtain further information about the MM.
